IYF Youth Empowerment Initiative

In response to the challenges faced by youth, the International Youth Fellowship (IYF) launched the Youth Empowerment Initiative—a transformative program aimed at equipping young people with the mindset, skills, and values to overcome life's hardships and become future leaders. Through this initiative, participants are introduced to the "world of the heart," where they learn the power of mindset, develop strong character, and build the resilience necessary to face adversity with confidence.

There are various programs in the Youth Empowerment Initiative

 Every Saturday, IYF offers free skills training academies designed to empower youth in entrepreneurship and self-employment. Our diverse range of classes Includes ICT, Fashion Design, Pastry, Camera Operations, Music, Dance, Mindset Education, French, Business and Marketing and more.

We provide a comprehensive 3-month certifloste course covering these topics, with eeeelons held weekly on Saturdays and Sundays. Participante will also benefit from internship and placement opportunities through IYF, our partner organizations, schools, and established MOUS.

The Construction Academy course is a full-time, 3 month program that includes acommodation, designed to support the hands-on nature of the training. A dedicated space has been allocated for building the accommodation facility.

Upon completion, we connect trafnoce with our branches and supply occontial equipment, euch as interlocking brick-making machines. We also provide carpentry workshop tools and electrical matorfals for youth groups and others. This support extende to all training programs.



- 3. The IYF Youth Empowerment Initiative training follows a cohort system, with membership ID cards issued to graduates, allowing them to access the facilities for their projects and request support.
- 4. Since IYF provides free programs, there is a risk that some youth may not take it seriously. To address this, we've implemented an attendance management system. Each participant receives a passport booklet to track their attendance, and bonus points are awarded to those who exceed expectations and engage in community service and volunteer activities organized during their training.
- 5. All trainees are required to attend mandatory life skills and leadership mindset training alongside their program. Certificates are be awarded to those who successfully complete the academy, meeting the established assessment standards.
- 6. We have teachers and assistants from partner colleges, TVET institutions, and alumni from previous cohorts placed as interns, all of whom are remunerated by IYF.
